Rembrandt was a Baroque artist born in 1606, in the Netherlands.

Rembrandt's used close, direct observation to paint self-portraits.

Romero Britto is a modern artist who uses cubism, pop art and graffiti.

A self portrait is a drawing, painting or sculpture created by the artist, of themselves.
