Attendance

Attendance is regarded as a Safeguarding issue.

Parental Responsibility for Attendance

Parents are legally responsible for ensuring their child's regular attendance at school. The department for Education and Somerset Council automatically monitor pupil attendance daily through the school registers. The Department for Education informs the Headteacher every two weeks the monitored attendance details of absent pupils. The School Attendance worker will make contact if your child is identified in this monitoring.

If you are worried about your child/children's attendance the first port of call is to discuss your concerns with the school attendance worker – Mrs Sue Wright.

Parking outside school

Parking illegally or disrespectfully - Residents have complained about the illegal, inconsiderate and sometimes dangerous parking of parents/Carers before and after school.



We would like to make parents aware of the Highway Code 243 which includes the following:

(from www.police.uk)

Pick-up and drop-off times are busy outside schools. This can cause an increased safety risk to both children and parents.

Parking restrictions outside schools are there to keep you and your children safe. Parking inconsiderately can put people in danger and you also risk being fined. It's important that motorists follow the [Highway Code](#).

Parking restrictions outside schools

Understanding yellow zigzag markings. Most school entrances and exits in the UK have yellow zigzag road markings with the writing 'School Keep Clear'. They indicate the part of the road where motorists should not wait, stop, or park a vehicle. Both yellow and white zigzags also show areas that must be kept clear so that children and other road users can see clearly when crossing the road.

Parking on yellow zigzags

Yellow zigzags without accompanying signs advise motorists not to wait or park there at any time for the safety of children and others. We can issue tickets for parking on them, based on causing an obstruction to other motorists or pedestrians. **DO NOT** stop or park:

- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- at or near a bus or tram stop or taxi rank
- on the approach to a level crossing/tramway crossing
- opposite or within 10 meters (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space
- near the brow of a hill or hump bridge
- opposite a traffic island or (if this would cause an obstruction) another parked vehicle
- where you would force other traffic to enter a tram lane
- where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users and powered mobility vehicles
- in front of an entrance to a property
- on a bend
- where you would obstruct cyclists' use of cycle facilities.

Useful Information

Who are the people offering the activities? Organisations who have experience of working with children and young people with a disability or additional need and have formally agreed to be referred to by the Inclusion and Young People's teams who would be in contact. Please call them to check about your child / young person's needs.

Activities offered by the Community Inclusion and Activity Team: Dependent on the child / young person needs, we can provide a 1:1 or self-led period (1:1 or self-led group sessions £10 to the first hour and £10 / young person for additional 1:1 or self-led hour, all second hours will need to be booked. We require payment a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the day. Please note, spaces for children and young people with a disability or additional needs will be prioritised first, with spaces offered to children and young people with other needs if we have space.

Don't Forget our Activity Day Present: Available to all families in Somerset with a child or young person with a disability or additional need. Present Pack, Booklet or Card, The Inclusion Day Present, Activity Book, Activity Booklet, Handwritten presents, Craft Book, Travel calendar, Somerset guide for first and more at www.somerset.gov.uk/activity or see the form.

Mini Card: A FREE card for all children and young people with a disability or additional need in Somerset aged 0-25 years. The card can be used at many places all over the UK offering discounts and special rates when you show the card. Visit www.somerset.gov.uk/mini-card for more information on how to obtain the card. Cards can ONLY be issued by Somerset Council or people listed in the document.
